And furthermore, the future world we are talking about will not be controlled by angels. [6] For in one place the Scriptures say, "What are people that you should think of them, or a son of man that you should care for him?[7] Yet you made them only a little lower than the angels and crowned them with glory and honor. [8] You gave them authority over all things."

4 **Hebrews 2:5-8**

[9] What we do see is Jesus, who "for a little while was made lower than the angels" and now is "crowned with glory and honor" because he suffered death for us.
